This privacy notice explains how we use your personal data and how you can exercise your rights regarding that information.

Information we are collecting about you

- Your name
- Your Personal Reference Number (PRN) issued by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC)
- Your email address and phone number
- Your country of qualification as a nurse or midwife
- Your examination results and feedback by station
- Any information to support your application for reasonable adjustments or mitigating circumstances
- Video and audio recordings of your OSCE exam

What is the source of the personal data?

Information is sourced from the individual and checked against the candidate's application for an OSCE on the NMC's secure portal.

Why we are collecting your personal data

- For the management and administration of the OSCE examination, assessment, moderation and feedback to the candidate and to the NMC
- to process aspects of your exam data with our partners for the purposes of moderation
- for research purposes to explore your experience of the OSCE exam journey
- to process a range of continuing professional development opportunities
- to process feedback on your performance with your OSCE preparation training team, only if you are unsuccessful

The lawful basis for processing your personal data

Consent under Article 6(1)(a) of the UK GDPR



Who are we sharing your personal data with?

- Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC)
- Other test centres and/or the NMC's quality assurance partner
- Your OSCE preparation training team
- UON's research and marketing teams

How long we will process your personal data for

Data is retained in accordance with UON's Data Retention Policy and schedule, which are available to view on request to ctc@northampton.ac.uk

What are your rights and how can you enforce them?

- Right to withdraw consent
- Right to be informed
- Right of access
- Right of rectification
- Right to erasure
- Right to restriction
