A top-up degree is the final year (Level 6) of an undergraduate degree course and allows you to top-up your existing qualification to a full BA, BSc or BEng degree.

UON is a great location for your Top-Up studies, being close to major cities, including London, yet with achievable entry requirements, affordable living costs and onward progression to prestigious UK universities for your Master's.

We are also recognised for our outstanding support for students in key areas:

Academic Support

Our dedicated International Student Support Team will help with any issue or guide you to other advisers for specialised assistance. Whether it's referencing, additional study materials, or improving your writing or maths skills, we have helpful and friendly staff to guide you.

Wellbeing

We have an on-campus Medical Centre and will help you register with a doctor, but your mental and emotional health is just as important as your physical health. Graduate progression

International students who complete their Bachelor's degree at UON will have various opportunities open to them after they graduate, including:

- pursuing further education by enrolling in a Master's programme at UON, or any other institution in the UK. This allows you to deepen your knowledge in your field of study and enhance your career prospects. The University of Northampton's International Graduate Scholarship offers a 30% fee discount to UON graduates who studied on-campus in the UK. This scholarship is available if you wish to study a Master's course and have achieved a second class degree.
- opting for the UK's Graduate Route visa, which permits you to stay in the UK for up to two years after graduation to work or seek employment opportunities. This pathway enables you to gain valuable work experience and potentially transition to a work visa or other immigration routes in the UK.
- as an international student, you can consider returning to your home country or exploring job opportunities in other countries, utilising the skills and knowledge acquired during your studies in the UK.

Accommodation



Moving overseas is a big step, so it helps if you don't need to worry about where you'll be living. Our Halls of Residence offer all you need to relax, make friends, socialise and study. We take your safety seriously, so all sites have 24-hour security and a dedicated

Residential Life Team to support you through any issues you may have.

Value for money

With rents from £93 per week* you could save as much as £2,000 over three years, compared to competitor universities. Accommodation is fully furnished, with all utility bills, personal possessions insurance and University computer network and Wi-Fi access included - so no surprise costs! All that's left for you to pay is for a licence to watch TV if you want one in your own room.

More choice

Many students love the convenience of living on-campus. Our research shows that, taking into account age of accommodation, proximity to campus, cost of least expensive comparable accommodation and ensuite provision, UON offers more affordable accommodation than 70% of our key competitors.**

Whether you want to be on-campus, off-campus, or in the town centre, we have the right option to suit you. What's more, if you choose to live in our off-campus Scholar's Green Student Village, we provide a free weekday bus service to campus. And when it comes to types of room, you're spoilt for choice - with single or twin ensuite rooms (large or small), single or twin studio flats, or shared townhouses.

Private sector accommodation

If you prefer to live in private rented accommodation, our Private Sector Housing Team will provide details of available properties that meet our high safety standards. Regional private sector rents are almost 20% lower than the national average - but remember, you will be responsible for household bills.

Entry requirements, Tuition Fees & Scholarships

Entry requirements

To join a BA or BSc Top-Up programme, you must hold an HND or have completed the equivalent of two years UK undergraduate study in a relevant subject area. In addition, you must hold IELTS 6.0 (or equivalent) with a minimum of 5.5 in all bands*. To join our MSc Accounting and Finance Top-Up you will have successfully completed professional qualifications such as AIA, ACA, ACCA, CIMA, ICAP, or CPA Australia, or an international equivalent such as OTHM Level 7 Diploma in Accounting and Finance (RQF).

In addition, you must hold IELTS 6.5 (or equivalent) with a minimum of 5.5 in all bands. We offer Pre-Sessional English Programmes if you have not yet reached this level of English.

Tuition fees

The one-year undergraduate top-up fee for 2025-26 is £17,000.

Scholarships

Our International Scholarship scheme offers a tuition fee reduction of 10%, 20% or 30%. This is awarded automatically based on your academic achievement, so you do not need to apply separately (Terms and Conditions apply).

*Our Commerce and International Business Top-Up and International Banking and Finance Top-Up courses accept students with an overall IELTS score of 5.5. as they include English Language tuition.



How to apply

Once you've decided that you would like to study with us, our aim is to make the application process as straightforward as possible. So we can consider your application, you'll need to include the following documentation:

Your education history

Tell us where you studied, what qualifications you already have and include copies of your certificates or transcripts. If you have studies you've not yet completed, include your predicted result, then send us your final results as soon as you have them.

Proof of English language competence

Please check the course-specific requirements on our website.

A Personal Statement

Explain why you would like to study your chosen course and what you plan to do with your qualification.

A reference or letter of recommendation

If you're still studying or have recently completed your studies, this should be from one of your teachers, explaining your academic potential and suitability for the course. If you're in work, this should be from your employer.
